

Enlarged Images of 23 Pictures

From the 1947 Nichols High School Mirror Yearbook

The first six volumes of the Nichols High School Mirror yearbook (1944-1949) were in all aspects totally a creation of the student Mirror staff. The staff created the content, photographed the pictures, produced and printed the proofs, pasted in reserved spaces on the printed pages actual 3x5 black and white glossy prints of photographs, and bound every individual copy. The subsequent twelve volumes of the Mirror yearbook (1950-1961) were produced by a commercial publishing company.

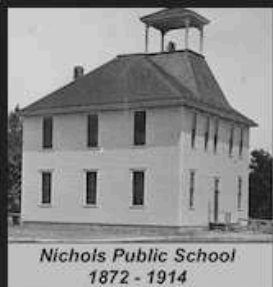
The 3x5 black and white glossy photographic prints in the 1947 volume are an especially valuable collection. (1) The 3x5 prints, though 71 years old, are in "like new" condition in this the year 2018. (2) The high resolution on the glossy photo stock permits scanning of enlarged images. It is these enumerated circumstances that prompt the assembling of this special collection of enlarged photographic images in 2018 from the 1947 NHS Mirror yearbook.



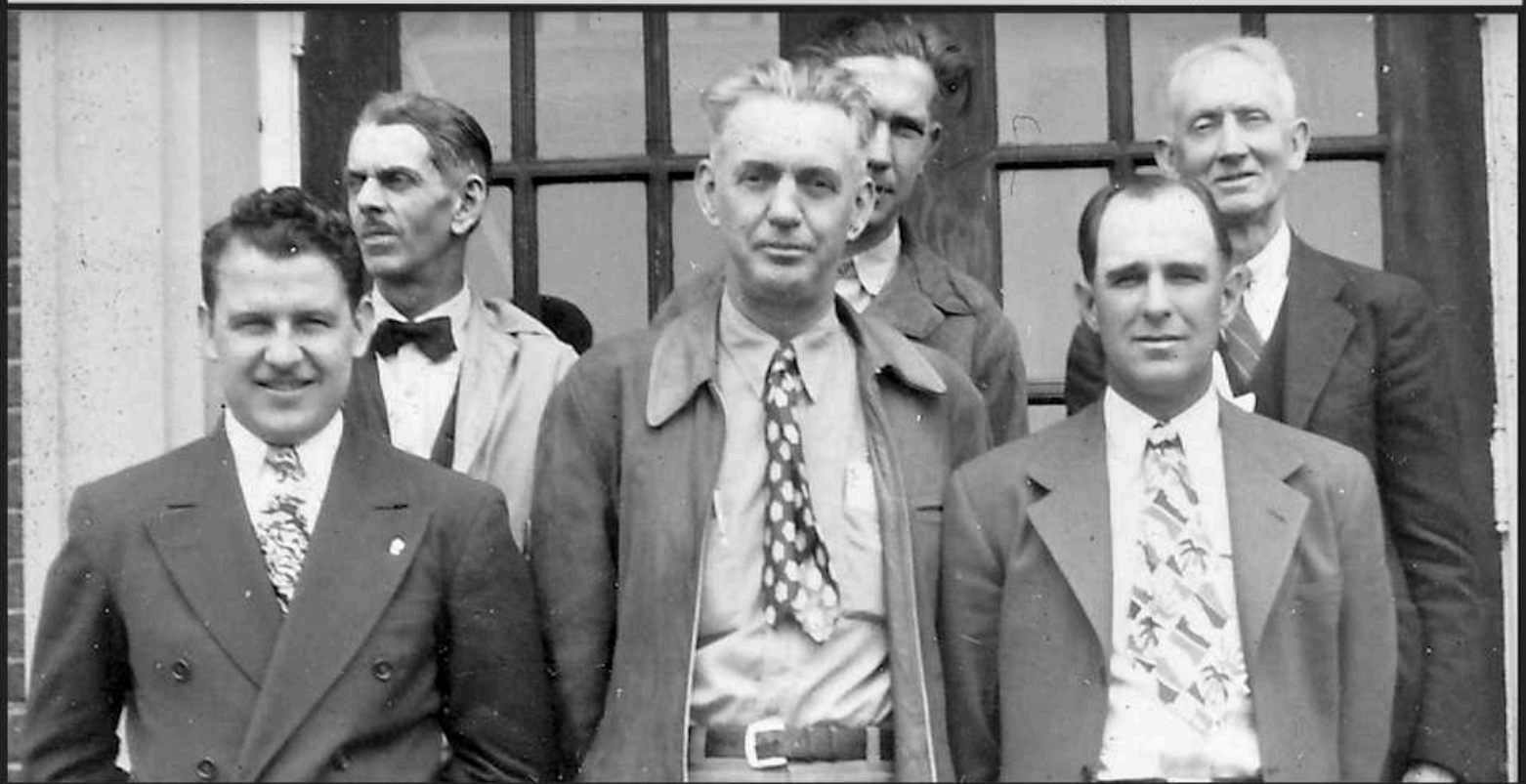
OUR DEDICATION

In 1872 a two-story white wood frame public school building was erected at the north end of the Town of Nichols. That building was destroyed by fire in February, 1914. Monday, November 29, 1915, was the first day of school in this new three-story brick school building erected on the east side of the Town of Nichols during 1914 and 1915. The gymnasium on the northwest corner was erected during the year 1934.

"OUR TRANSPORTATION. This past year several of the rural schools were closed and to provide transportation for these children to Nichols School, it was necessary to secure buses. We were not capable of getting a new bus right away, so we bought a second-hand bus to use until the new one arrived. Early in January our new 146 Chevrolet bus arrived. ... Mr. and Mrs. Walter Juels and Max Hanft served as competent drivers for the buses. Lee Ulch and Raymond Porter drove before the above took over."

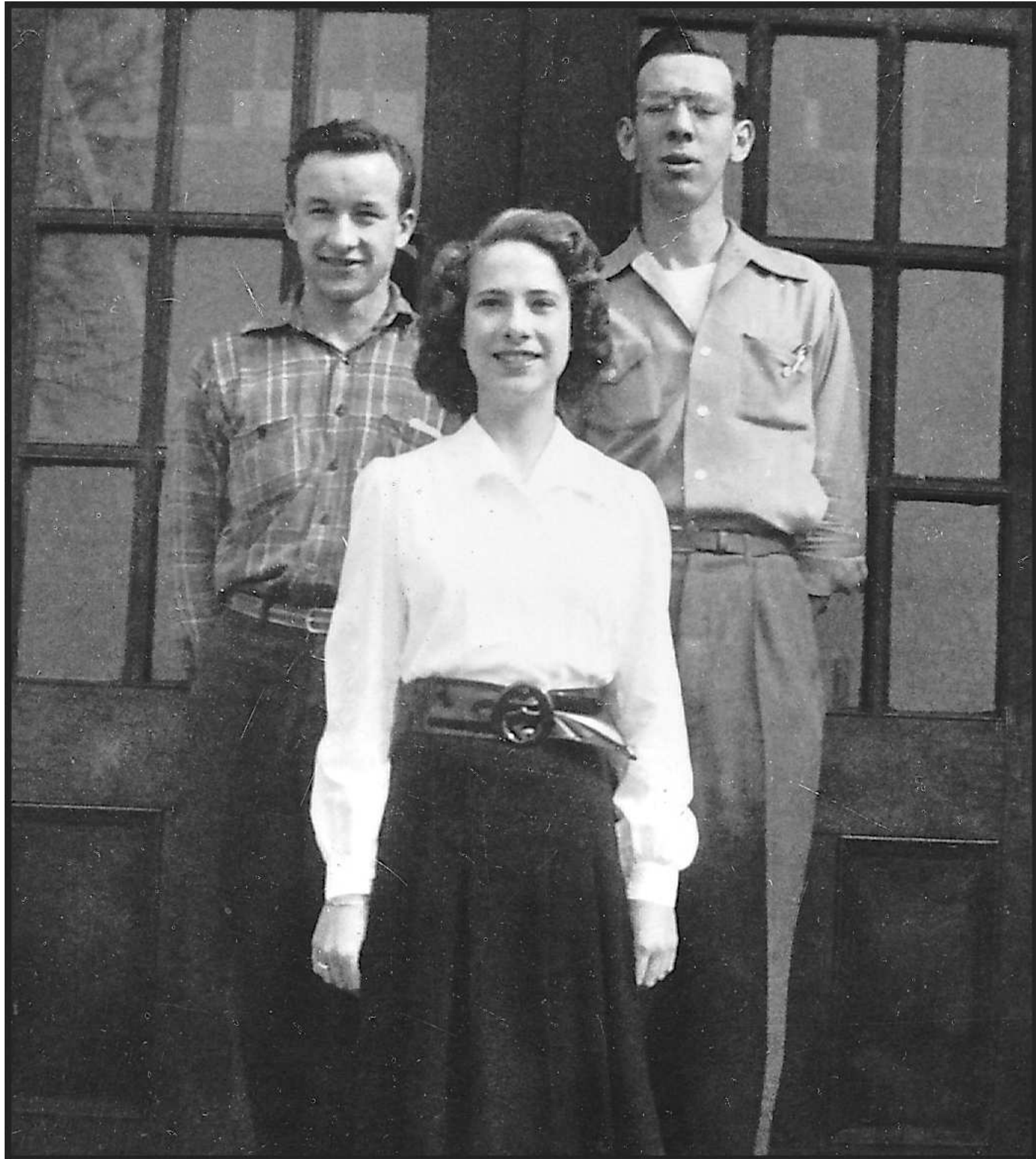

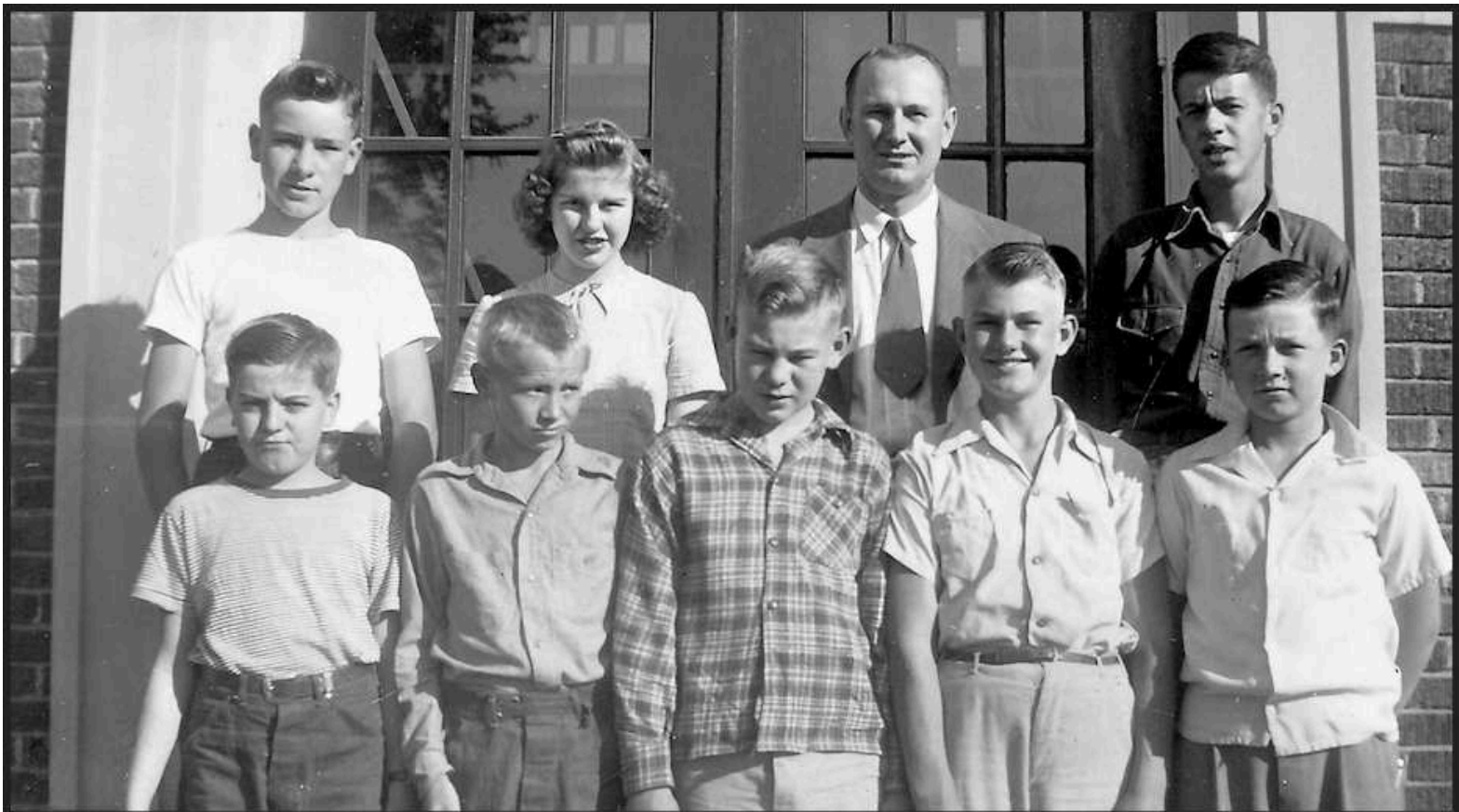

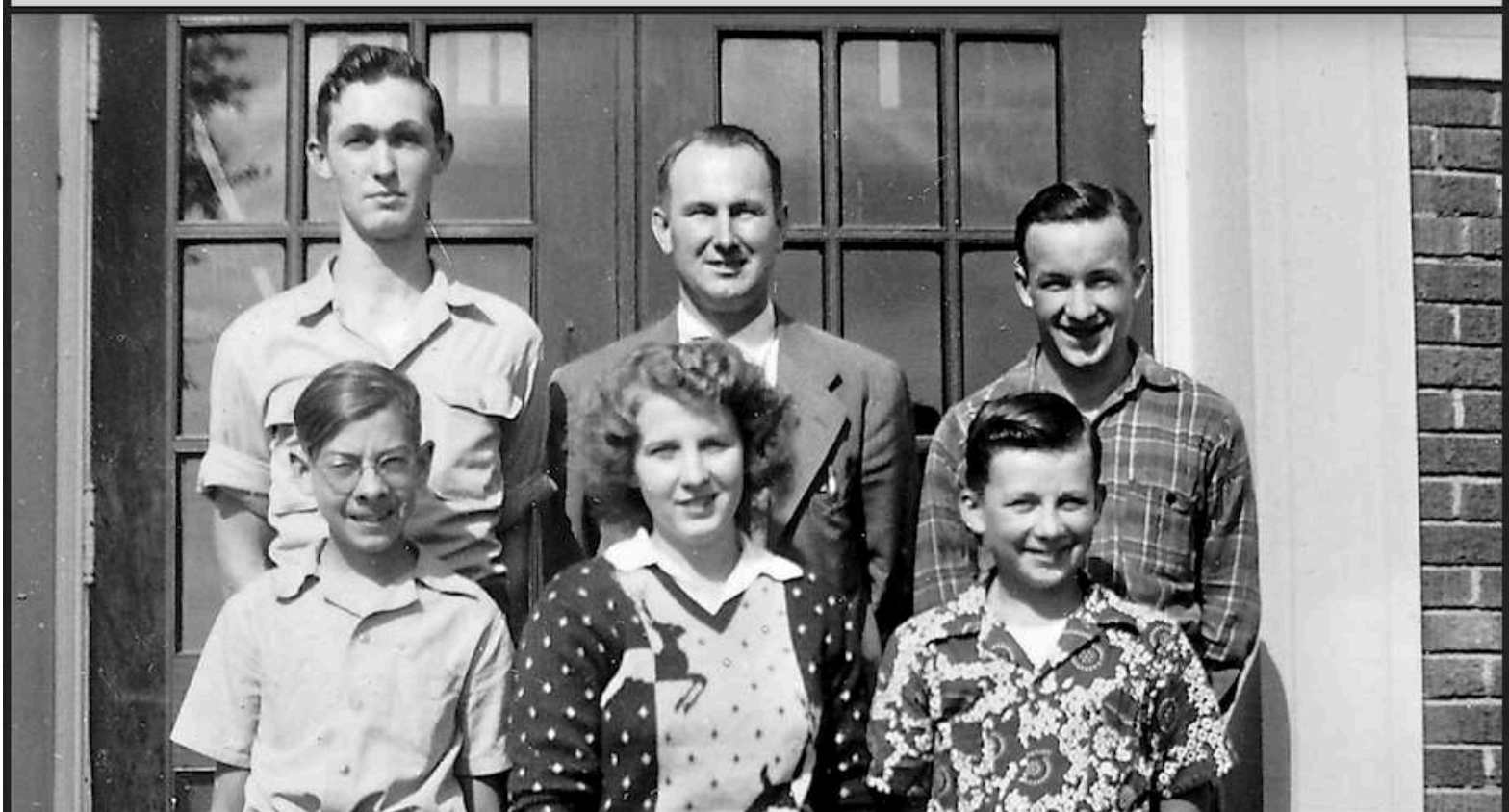
