Code of Conduct Policy

Musser Public Library is committed to securing a safe atmosphere conducive to the use of its resources and services. To that end, the Library has established the following Code of Conduct.

The Code of Conduct applies to all persons using the Library facility, the library grounds and the library parking. Persons violating the rules may be asked to leave the premises and may be barred from the library premises for the periods listed on the following chart.
